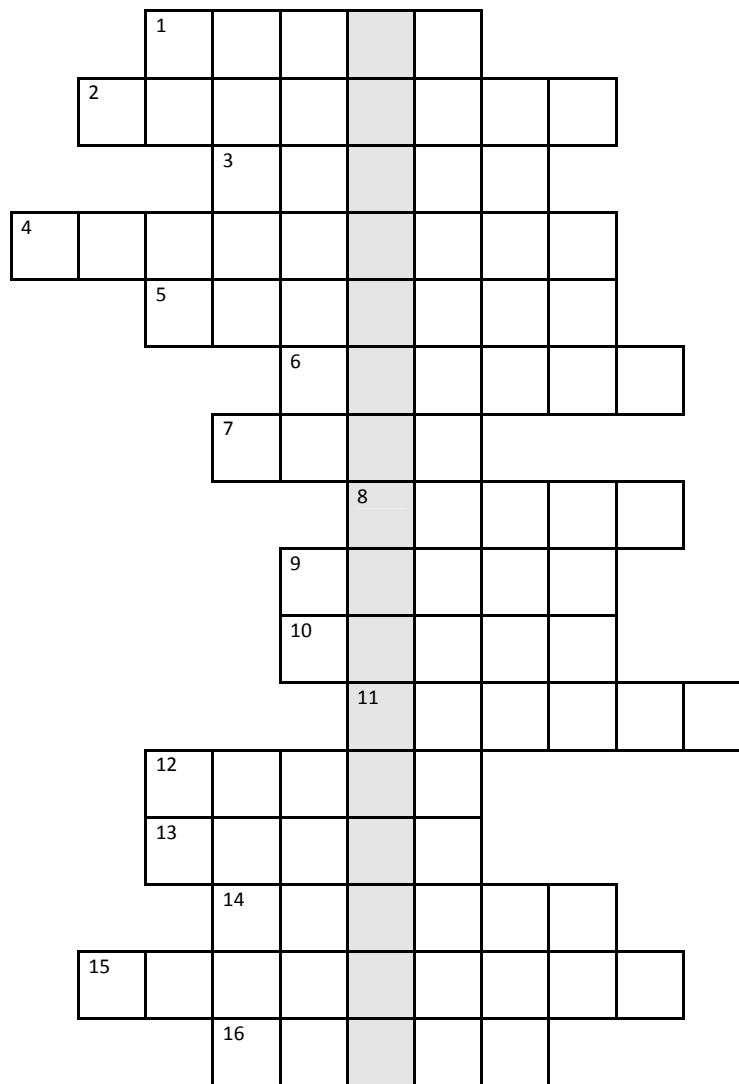


How Wakinyan Tanka Moves
