



Exploratory Latin Exam Syllabus Addendum for Grades 5 and Above

While all students participating in the 2006-2007 Exploratory Latin Exam must answer the first 30 questions which are based upon the general syllabus, students who are in grade 5 and above must answer an additional twenty questions. Questions 31-40 are based upon the same general syllabus, differing from the first 30 questions only in degree of difficulty. Questions 41-50 are based upon the theme “Entertainment in the Ancient World.” The syllabus for these final ten questions is found below.
